# **Position purpose**

To support TNS staff and students through coordinating Learning Support across K-10, in collaboration with the Head of School and in accordance with The Nature School's objectives and philosophy.

### **Essential Criteria**

- 1. Qualification as a Teacher with Proficient Accreditation status in NSW
- 2. Additional qualifications or experience in Learning Support
- 3. Strong written and oral communication skills, and time management
- 4. Demonstrated ability to work both independently, and collaboratively with colleagues
- 5. Current Working With Children Check (for paid employment)
- 6. Current Senior First Aid accreditation
- 7. Love of nature and the environment, and adequate fitness levels for outdoor adventures

#### **Desirable Criteria**

- 1. Experience in a combined Primary / Secondary school context
- 2. Experience in delivering outdoor education programs or teaching outside

### **Key responsibilities**

- Support Teachers in the preparation and implementation of Individual Programs (IPs) for students with additional needs
- Work with the Teaching & Learning Coordinator to ensure appropriate differentiation and adjustments are provided within teaching programs and within the classroom
- Oversee all documentation required for the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data (NCCD)
- Coordinate the implementation of any programs to identify and support students with additional needs, in conjunction with the Head of School
- Lead the Teacher Aide team, in conjunction with the Assistant Head of School
- Work with Assistant Head and Stage Coordinators to ensure Teacher Aide timetables appropriately support the learning of students with additional needs
- Provide professional learning to colleagues in the area of Learning Support
- Liaise with families regarding their child's Learning Support needs

#### **Allowance**

• Remuneration – Additional duties allowance provided above relevant teacher salary
